The 2017 keynote address will be delivered by commentator and TV/radio host **Callie Crossley**.

Ms. Crossley was a producer for Blackside Inc.'s "Eyes on the Prize: America's Civil Rights Years," which earned her an Oscar® nomination, a National Emmy, and the Alfred I. DuPont-Columbia Award (Gold Baton). A former producer for ABC News 20/20, Ms. Crossley is a Woodrow Wilson Visiting Fellow,



guest-lecturing at colleges and universities about media literacy, media and politics and the intersection of race, gender and media.

Other invited speakers include Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker, Boston Mayor Martin Walsh, U.S. Senator Elizabeth Warren, U.S. Senator Ed Markey, and Massachusetts Attorney General Maura Healey.

Past keynote speakers include civil rights legend Joseph Lowery, Yolanda King, MSNBC anchor Melissa Harris-Perry, and Ambassador Charles Stith. The New England Gospel Ensemble will provide musical entertainment at the 47th MLK Memorial Breakfast.

# Scholarships

### empowering the next generation

Each year, the MLK Breakfast, through corporate sponsorships, provides \$2,500 college scholarships and educational achievement awards to students from four Boston schools.



Based on their essay submission about King's impact, five graduating seniors from Jeremiah Burke, Madison Park, and John D. O'Bryant high schools are awarded scholarship support for their higher education. Awards are paid to students' colleges upon successful matriculation.



For the last decade, 8th grade students at the **Orchard Gardens K-8 School** present artwork based on the theme "What Dr. King's Dream Means to Me." The top five submissions are presented at the MLK Breakfast and the student artist receives a cash award.
